

CONDITIONS:

- 1 Entries close 5.00pm on Thursday 10th August 2023 with signed entry fees.
Late entries will be charged a late fee of \$10
 - 2 No telephone entries will be accepted.
 - 3 Email entries accepted to **kadinahiaentries@gmail.com**
 - 4 **SATURDAY 8.30am start SUNDAY 8.30am start**
 - 5 Riders must choose in which ring to ride. No events will be held.
 - 6 No Horses allowed to work on outer (trotting) track.
 - 7 No space holding is permitted for late arrivals.
 - 8 Horse's names must be on entry forms with exhibitors' name.
 - 9 No one is allowed in the ring without permission from the horse committee.
 - 10 No Stallions be allowed except in jumping, APSB or harness events.
 - 11 The by-laws on Tests and Swabbing approved by S. A. Branch of the E.A., effective from Nov. 1981, will apply to this show. The Committee reserves the right to take a swab from any horse or pony. For up-to-date rules see <http://www.equestrian.org.au/?Page=32984>
 - 12 Stewards have the right to measure any horse or pony before entering the ring unless a current height certificate is produced. Any horse or pony entered in a wrong class, can be reclassified. Substitutes will be accepted at the discretion of Committee. Horse measurements will be taken with shoe allowance. *If any protest over height the horse or Pony may be measured at the show, or a height certificate must be produced within 7 days.
 - 13 Any exhibit which, in the opinion of the committee, has been fraudulently entered may be disqualified, & the exhibitor disqualified from taking any prizes at this show.
 - 14 Riders will be advised that their classes will be called 5 min. before they are due to appear before judging. Failure to respond to a call could mean disqualification of that class.
 - 15 All riders to wear safety standard approved helmets when mounted.
 - 16 First, second, & third prize ribbons will be awarded in all classes specified.
 - 17 Exhibitors to be properly attired when competing in each ring.
 - 18 Ages stated for rider classes are the age of rider on show day.
 - 19 The Committee reserves the right to cancel, alter or change any event at its discretion.

- 20 Each competitor required to leave their area, at the end of the day, cleared of all horse related refuse and placed in trailer allotted for your benefit as well as for the Kadina Show Society.
 - 21 Thank you in anticipation of keeping the grounds clean

CRITERIA: HACKS & HUNTERS

To be considered to compete in Horse classes at the 2023 Royal Adelaide Show the following qualifying performances will be required.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU CHECK THE SA COUNTRY SHOWS WEBSITE TO ENSURE AGRICULTURAL WINS ARE OBTAINED FROM AN AFFILIATED AGRICULTURAL SHOW.

MINIMUM QUALIFYING PERFORMANCES—HACK & HUNTER Classes (eligibility for entry):

Competitors must obtain the minimum performances listed below to qualify for the Royal Adelaide Show competition for: HACK Section:

HACK, GALLOWAY HACK, PONY HACK and EQUESTRIAN Classes.

SHOW HUNTER Section:

SHOW HUNTER HORSE, SHOW HUNTER GALLOWAY, SHOW HUNTER PONY, and EQUESTRIAN classes.

1. A minimum of three (3) first placings in an open height or weight or Lady's or Gentleman's class in the current season (ie) 21st May 2021 to 20th May 2022 at three (3) separate agricultural shows affiliated with the Agricultural Societies Council. No more than one (1) win per day per show will be accepted as a qualifying performance.
2. OR: - Two (2) first placings and two (2) second placings in an open height or weight or Lady's or Gentleman's class in the current season (ie) 21st May 2021—20th May 2022 at five (5) separate agricultural shows affiliated with the

Agricultural Societies Council. No more than one (1) win/placing per day per show will be accepted as a qualifying performance.

3. OR: -Six (6) second placings in an open height or weight or Lady's or Gentleman's class in the current season (ie) 21st May 2021—20th May 2022 at six (6) separate agricultural shows affiliated with the Agricultural Societies Council. No more than one (1) placing per day per show will be accepted as a qualifying performance.

Any Champion Hack, Champion Galloway Hack, Champion Pony Hack, Champion Show Hunter Horse, Champion Show Hunter Galloway or Champion Show Hunter Pony gained at any capital city Royal Show (including State & Territory capital city Royal Shows but excluding Melbourne Summer Royal) in the 12 months prior to the closing date of entries will gain automatic acceptance to compete at the forthcoming Royal Adelaide Show.
